

Courage

Revelation 3:15-19 – I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. `So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth. `Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing, " and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked, I advise you to buy from Me gold refined by fire so that you may become rich, and white garments so that you may clothe yourself, and that the shame of your nakedness will not be revealed; and eye salve to anoint your eyes so that you may see. `Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; therefore be zealous and repent.

Luke 9:62 – But Jesus said to him, "No one, after putting his hand to the plow and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."

Acts 20:24 – But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the Gospel of the grace of God.

Matthew 8:20 – Jesus said to him, "The foxes have holes and the birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His head."

Luke 9:60 – But He said to him, "Allow the dead to bury their own dead; but as for you, go and proclaim everywhere the kingdom of God."

Philippians 3:10 – That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being conformed to his death;

Deuteronomy 28:47 – Because you served not the LORD your God with joyfulness, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all [things];

Joshua 1:5-6 – No one will be able to stand against you as long as you live. I will be with you, just as I was with Moses. I will not leave you or forsake you. Be strong and of a good courage: to this people shall you divide an inheritance the land, which I swore to their fathers to give them.

Joshua 10:25 – And Joshua said unto them, Fear not, nor be dismayed, be strong and of good courage: for this shall the LORD do to all your enemies against whom all of you fight.

1 Chronicles 22:13 – Then shall you prosper, if you take heed to fulfill the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed.

1 Chronicles 28:20 – And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do [it]: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, [even] my God, [will be] with you; he will not fail you, nor forsake you, until you hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

Proverbs 28:1 – The wicked flees when no man pursues: but the righteous are as bold as a lion.

Matthew 26:39 – And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as you [will].

Numbers 13:20 – "And what the land [is], whether it [be] fat or lean, whether there be woods, or not. And all of you be exceedingly brave, and bring of the fruit of the land."

2 Samuel 7:27 – "For You, O LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, have made a revelation to Your servant, saying, 'I will build you a house' Therefore Your servant has found courage to pray this prayer to You.

2 Chronicles 15:7-8 – "But you, be strong and do not lose courage, for there is reward for your work." Now when Asa heard these words and the prophecy which Azariah the son of Oded the prophet spoke, he took courage and removed the abominable idols from all the land of Judah and Benjamin and from the cities which he had captured in the hill country of Ephraim. He then restored the altar of the LORD which was in front of the porch of the LORD.

2 Chronicles 32:5 – And he took courage and rebuilt all the wall that had been broken down and erected towers on it, and built another outside wall and strengthened the Millo in the city of David, and made weapons and shields in great number.

Psalms 27:14 – Wait for the LORD; Be strong and let your heart take courage; Yes, wait for the LORD.

Psalms 31:24 – Be strong and let your heart take courage, all of you who hope in the LORD.

Isaiah 35:4 – Say to those with anxious heart, "Take courage, fear not. Behold, your God will come with vengeance; The recompense of God will come, But He will save you."

Micah 3:8 – On the other hand I am filled with power-- with the Spirit of the LORD -- and with justice and courage To make known to Jacob his rebellious act, even to Israel his sin.

Haggai 2:4 – 'But now take courage, Zerubbabel,' declares the LORD, 'take courage also, Joshua son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and all you people of the land take

courage,' declares the LORD, 'and work; for I AM with you,' declares the LORD of hosts.

Mark 6:50 – for they all saw Him and were terrified. But immediately He spoke with them and said to them, "Take courage; it is I, do not be afraid."

Acts 23:11 – But on the night immediately following, the Lord stood at his side and said, "Take courage; for as you have solemnly witnessed to My cause at Jerusalem, so you must witness at Rome also."

Acts 27:25 – "Therefore, keep up your courage, men, for I believe God that it will turn out exactly as I have been told.

2 Corinthians 5:6-8 – Therefore, being always of good courage, and knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord: (For we walk by faith, not by sight) We are confident, [I say], and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Philippians 1:14 – and that most of the brethren, trusting in the Lord because of my imprisonment, have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear.

Genesis 14:14-16 – And when Abram heard that his brother was taken captive, he armed his 318 trained [servants], born in his own house, and pursued [them] to Dan. He divided his forces against them by night, he and his servants, and defeated them, and pursued them as far as Hobah, which is north of Damascus. He brought back all the goods, and also brought back his brother Lot with his possessions, and also the women, and the people.

Philippians 3:13 – Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but [this] one thing [I do], forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forward to those things which are ahead.
