

Why Praise and Thank God?

God is with you

Psalms 22:3 - But you [are] holy, [O you] that inhabits the praises of Israel.

God will honor you

1 Samuel 2:30 - ... the LORD saith, “Be it far from me; for them that honor me I will honor, and they that despise me shall be lightly esteemed.”

Jeremiah 30:19 - And out of them shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of them that make merry: and I will multiply them, and they shall not be few; I will also glorify them, and they shall not be small.

God makes you strong

Psalms 8:2 - Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength (which per Matthew 21:16 is “perfected praise”) because of your enemies, that you might still the enemy and the avenger.

God fights for you

2 Chronicles 20:22 - And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

Thunderous Victory is Yours

Acts 16:25-26 - And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.
